Tribulation: Not From God

This isn't complicated and it is simply and irrefutably true.

Let's see who has true reverence for Almighty (Yahweh) God and reverence for the Truth.

There are those who advocate that the tribulation period is the wrath of God. Sorry, but no. The very word "tribulation" has never been nor ever will be attributed to having been authored by, originating with, or proceeding from Almighty God or anything in His presence.

Let's start with

Deut. 4: 30

When thou art in {tribulation}, and all these things are come upon thee, [even] in the latter days, if thou turn to the LORD thy God, and shalt be obedient unto his voice; 31 (For the LORD thy God [is] a merciful God;) he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them.

^ The Strong's word here for tribulation is the Hebrew word *tsar tsâr - tsar, tsawr* (6862) meaning an opponent, adversary, afflicted (-tion), anguish, close, distress, enemy, flint, foe, narrow, small, sorrow, strait, tribulation, trouble.

Next we have

Judges 10:13

Yet ye have forsaken me, and served other gods: wherefore I will deliver you no more. 14 Go and cry unto the gods which ye have chosen; let them deliver you in the time of your {tribulation}. 15 And the children of Israel said unto the LORD, We have sinned: do thou unto us whatsoever seemeth good unto thee; deliver us only, we pray thee, this day. 16 And they put away the strange gods from among them, and served the LORD: and his soul was grieved for the misery of Israel.

^ The Strong's word here is the Hebrew word *tsârâh - tsaw-raw'* (6869) meaning adversary, adversity, affliction, anguish, distress, tribulation, trouble. This same word is used in

1 Samuel 26:

23 The LORD render to every man his righteousness and his faithfulness: for the

LORD delivered thee into [my] hand to day, but I would not stretch forth mine hand against the LORD'S anointed. 24 And, behold, as thy life was much set by this day in mine eyes, so let my life be much set by in the eyes of the LORD, and let him deliver me out of all (tribulation). 25 Then Saul said to David, Blessed [be] thou, my son David: thou shalt both do great [things], and also shalt still prevail. So David went on his way, and Saul returned to his place.

The Word says in

John 10:10

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to {kill}, and to {destroy}: (I guess many would attribute that to God also)... I am come that they might have life, and that they might have [it] more abundantly.

Rev. 12:12

"Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the *devil* has come down to you, having *great wrath*, because he knows that he has a short time."

The Greek word thlipsis (Strong's 2347) used in the New Testament means afflicted (-tion), anguish, burdened, persecution, tribulation, trouble.

Matthew 24:9

"Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted (thlipsis), and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake."

Matt 24:5

For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.

6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all [these things] must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.

8 All these [are] the beginning of sorrows.

9 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall {kill} you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.

10 And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.

11 And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.

12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

13 But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

16 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:

17 Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house:

18 Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.

19 And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days!

20 But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:

21 For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.

22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

The final word on this subject is this from

James 1:12-16

Blessed [is] the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him. 13 Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: 14 But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. 15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death. 16 Do not err, my beloved brethren.

Look again when Satan tried to get God to put tribulation on Job to see if Job would curse God and God refused BECAUSE God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man.

Accusing God of putting tribulation on mankind is the act of accusing God of being temped to doing EVIL to mankind and that for me ends the lie about the tribulation being Gods Wrath. That is why Rev. 12:12 says what it does.

Rev. 12:12

"Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the *devil* has come down to you, having *great wrath*, because he knows that he has a short time."

God Meets ALL Our Need According To What?

There is one POWERFUL understanding about the Kingdom of God being within those BEFORE Jesus died on the Cross. Try not to forget this is vital to understand. It has several parts and you should know the passages already.

Matt 6:21

For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

Matt 12:35

The good man out of the good treasure of the heart puts forth good things. And the evil man out of the evil treasure puts forth evil things.

God meets all our needs according to His Riches in Glory by the Anointing that is in God's YESHUA / WORD / PROMISES / SALVATION (ALL THE SAME THING).

That is the Treasure/Riches that Jesus spoke of as being of the good treasure of a good man's heart good things COME TO PASS and VICE VERSA for from the abundance of the HEART the MOUTH SPEAKS.

THIS ought to be one POWERFUL CLUE to ANYONE who would say that GOD ORIGINATED EVIL. FROM THE ABUNDANCE OF THE HEART THE MOUTH SPEAKS. Think on that hard and long.

What is it that we can find in any part of the Bible regarding ANYTHING that God ever spoke for any purpose that produced evil results?

AHHHH, what was it that Jesus even said of Himself in

Matt 19:17

And He said to him, Why do you call Me good? There is none good but one, that is, God. But if you want to enter into life, keep the commandments.

What exactly was he telling us about God Himself?

It is this: As being subordinate to God Himself (as even Jesus is), we can say things that do directly contradict (likewise not agree) with what God Almighty

has said (speaking in the spirit of opposition) and it obviously is not a sin to do so because Jesus did not sin and yet said, "Father let this cup pass from me, but nevertheless, not my will but Yours be done", but notice that Jesus corrected Himself and returned to agree again with Father.

BUT God Almighty Himself can not contradict Himself or BE TEMPTED TO DO EVIL!

HOW AWESOME THAT IS TO KNOW!!!

The KEYS TO THE KINGDOM OF GOD is the WORD / PROMISES / YESHUA / SALVATION that God Himself SPOKE and when He told all the men of old to KEEP / VOUCHSAFE / VAULT / SAFEGUARD their MOUTHS and HEARTS with GOD'S WORD it was for a specific reason!!!

[Prov. 4:19-27](#)

The way of the wicked *is* as darkness; they do not know at what they stumble. (20) My son, pay attention to my words; stretch your ear to what I say; (21) let them not depart from your eyes; keep them in the center of your heart; (22) for they *are* life to those who find them, and healing to all his flesh. (23) Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it *are* the issues of life. (24) Turn away from you the crooked mouth, and put perverse lips far from you. (25) Let your eyes look straight ahead, and let your eyelids look straight before you. (26) Study the track of your feet, then all your ways *will be* established. (27) Do not turn to the right hand or to the left; turn your foot aside from evil.

You should now KNOW that the TREASURE / GLORY OF GOD / KINGDOM OF GOD (ALL THE SAME THING) was in men's hearts and that was their SALVATION / HEALING / DELIVERANCE / FORTRESS / REFUGE / DIVINE PROTECTION (AGAIN ALL THE SAME THING) that SAVED them in time of trouble as they DECLARED / PROFESSED / CONFESSED / PROFESSION OF FAITH spoke out there MOUTHS what WAS IN ABUNDANCE IN THEIR HEARTS!!! THE KINGDOM OF GOD is WITHIN US ONLY WHEN THE WORD / PROMISES / YESHUA / SALVATION OF GOD IS ALIVE WITHIN US!!!

The key point here is the Word of God must be a LIVING REVELATION IN OUR SPIRIT to have the POWER to DO ANYTHING when we SPEAK IT!!! When you got SAVED, you SPOKE a LIVING REVELATION in your HEART that AGREED WITH SOMETHING THAT GOD HIMSELF ALREADY SAID and BOOOOM!!!! an EXPLOSION OF POWER INSIDE YOU CHANGED YOUR FUTURE!!!!

THE ONLY TRUTH THERE IS... IS THAT WHICH GOD HIMSELF SPOKE...
ALL ELSE IS CONTRADICTION / EVIL / SPIRIT OF OPPOSITION!!!

REMEMBER: LET YOUR WORD / PROMISES BE YES AND AMEN; ALL ELSE
PROCEEDS FROM **EVIL!!!**

ALL THAT GOD HAS EVER SAID AGREES WITH ITSELF AND NONE OF IT
HAS EVER PROCEEDED FROM **EVIL!!!**

GOD ALMIGHTY HAS NEVER FAILED TO BRING TO PASS ANY PROMISE
HE HAS EVER SPOKEN!!!

Matt. 5:37

But let your {word} (PROMISE) be Yes, yes; No, no. For the excess of these is
from evil.

Matt. 12:36

But I say to you, that every idle word (PROMISE), whatever men may speak,
they shall give an account of it in Judgment Day.

Rev. 12:12

"Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the
inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having
great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time."

Rom 2:5

But according to your hardness and your impenitent heart, do you treasure up to
yourself wrath in a day of wrath, and revelation of a righteous judgment of God?

If you absorb all that then this next part will be an added bonus. I will give you
the key passages... you may know them already.

Vital Endtime Key

Mark 13:32

But of that day and [that] hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in
heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.

Also found in

Matt 24:36

But of that day and hour knoweth no [man], no, not the angels of heaven, but my
Father only.

Here is the secret to the mystery of why Jesus Himself doesn't know of that day and hour. I'll give what the Word says and then you can root it out the same way I had to and wanted to know the truth bad enough to find it and not just go half way or turn around and look back to find a way to go around it but study for yourself to show thyself approved.

*** The Word says that Abraham's seed chose to have a man as a king instead of having God as Head and Sovereign Ruler over His people. So God informed them that He had authority over any man being king (sovereign ruler) of the people and like the turning of the rivers He would turn the kings heart any which way He choose to go. This He did with pharaoh in Egypt by hardening his heart showing that God's will had authority over pharaohs.

The Word says that God has given Jesus authority to rule as Head over the Body of Christ (Anointed Ones) to guide and influence with His Anointing (The Holy Spirit). As Christians we are Jesus's primary concern in this earth. The Word says Jesus sits at the right hand of the Father waiting 'til His enemies are made His footstool. The Word says that God the Father (God – Author, Originator, Creator, The Beginning of All Things, and The Completion of All Things) sets in Rule over the kings of the earth... Those two individual distinctions is the key to the "why doesn't Jesus know the day and hour?" in which He returns. This key opens the door to the most vital piece of information to the endtimes. The Word says that man is made of three parts: a spirit, a soul, and a body. The Word gave us a clue to who the antichrist is with the number 666. The Biblical numerics from God's Word says the number 6 represents *man*.

God dealing with the Pharaoh of Egypt was one of the first of many examples of Almighty God's power. Abraham's seed, many times, ignored God's warning of not letting heathen people bring their pagan gods and idols and diseases into the nation. The Word says God promised to protect His people but He being Holy and True could not break His own Ten Commandments and commit murder against people causing trouble in His nation. The Word says that God turned the heart of the heathen people's king against God's people to ravage them and do them harm. This activated the Promise of God's protection of His people and empowered them to rise up against the heathen people and destroy them to their complete end.

666 is the key to the nature of the antichrist because in this key you find that the endtime antichrist is not a fallen angel, and not satan made flesh, but in all three aspects (spirit, soul, and body) he is only a man. Simply put, the Word in Revelation shows Almighty Gods Sovereign Rule over any man that makes

himself sovereign and head of a nation and only God will know when to turn the sovereign head of the world / the antichrist's heart against God's people and forcing The Lord Jesus Christ's return at the sixth seal, with the sound of the trump, and you will see with your own eyes the fulfillment of 2 Samuel 22, Joel 2:1-11 and Rev.6:9-17 — The Great and Terrible Day of the Lord.

2 Sam 22:1-51

And David spoke to Jehovah the words of this song in the day Jehovah delivered him out of the hand of all his enemies, and out of the hand of Saul. (2) And he said: Jehovah *is* my rock and my fortress, and my Deliverer. (3) My God is my rock; I shall take refuge in Him; my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge! My Savior, You shall save me from violence. (4) I call on Jehovah, the One to be praised; and I shall be saved from my enemies. (5) When the waves of death surround me, the floods of the ungodly terrify me, (6) the cords of Sheol are all around me, the snares of death confronted me. (7) In my distress I called on Jehovah, and I called to my God. And He heard my voice from His temple, and my cry *was* in His ears. (8) And the earth shook and trembled, the foundations of the heavens were troubled, and were shaken; for He was angry. (9) Smoke rose up in His nostrils, and fire devoured out of His mouth; coals were kindled by it. (10) And He bowed the heavens and came down, and thick darkness *was* under His feet. (11) And He rode on a cherub, and did fly, and was seen on the wings of the wind. (12) And He made darkness pavilions all around Him, the gathering of waters, thick clouds of the skies. (13) From the brightness before Him were brands of fire kindled! (14) Jehovah thundered from the heavens, and the Most High gave forth His voice. (15) And He sent forth arrows and scattered them; lightning, and troubled them; (16) and the channels of the sea were seen; the world's foundations were revealed by the rebuke of Jehovah, from the blast of the breath of His nostrils. (17) He sent from above; He took me; He drew me out of many waters. (18) He delivered me from my strong enemy, from those who hated me; for they were stronger than me. (19) They confronted me in the day of my calamity, and Jehovah was my support; (20) and He brought me out to a large place; He delivered me, for He delighted in me. (21) Jehovah rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands, He has repaid me. (22) For I have kept the ways of Jehovah, and have not acted wickedly against my God. (23) For all His judgments *were* before me. As to His statutes, I did not turn away from them. (24) And I was blameless before Him, and I kept myself from my iniquity. (25) And Jehovah returned to me according to my righteousness, according to my cleanness in His eyes. (26) With the faithful You show Yourself kind. With the upright man, You will show Yourself upright. (27) With the pure, You will show Yourself pure, and with the perverted You will appear perverse. (28) And You shall save the afflicted people, and Your eyes *are* on the haughty, *whom* You bring low. (29) For You *are* my lamp, O Jehovah; and Jehovah shall light up my darkness. (30) For by You I have run *through* a troop; by my God I have leaped over a wall. (31) *As for* God, His way *is* perfect; the Word of Jehovah *is* tested; He is a shield to all those who seek refuge in Him. (32) For who *is* God except

Jehovah? And who *is* a rock except our God? (33) God is my strong fortress; and He sets the blameless free *in* his way, (34) making my feet like hinds' *feet*, even causing me to stand on my high places; (35) teaching my hands for battle, so that my hands may bend a bow of bronze. (36) And You have given to me the shield of Your salvation; and Your condescension has made me great. (37) You have enlarged my steps under me, and my feet have not slipped. (38) I have pursued my enemies and destroyed them; and I did not turn until they were consumed. (39) And I consumed them, and struck them, and they did not rise; but fell under my feet. (40) Yea, You girded me *with* might for battle; You caused those rising against me to bow under me. (41) And You gave to me the necks of my enemies; those hating me I silenced. (42) They looked, and there *was* none to save; to Jehovah, and He did not answer them. (43) And I beat them as the dust of the earth; I crushed them small as the mire of the streets; I spread them out. (44) And You delivered me from the strivings of my people; You kept me as the head of the nations; a people I have not known served me. (45) The sons of strangers submit to me; at the hearing of the ear they listen to me. (46) The sons of strangers fade away, and shall come trembling out of their strongholds. (47) Jehovah lives! And blessed is the Rock, and exalted be the God, the Rock of my salvation. (48) *He is* God who is giving vengeance for me, and brings down peoples under me, (49) and brings me forth from my enemies; yea, You raise me up above those rising up against me; You deliver me from the violent man. (50) On account of this I will confess You, Jehovah, among nations; and I will sing praise to Your name. (51) A tower of salvation *is* He to His king; even doing mercy to His anointed, to David and to his seed, until forever!

Joel 2:1-11

Blow the trumpet in Zion, And sound an alarm in My holy mountain! Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble; For the day of the Lord is coming, For it is at hand: A day of darkness and gloominess, A day of clouds and thick darkness, Like the morning clouds spread over the mountains. A people come, great and strong, The like of whom has never been; Nor will there ever be any such after them, Even for many successive generations. A fire devours before them, And behind them a flame burns; The land is like the Garden of Eden before them, And behind them a desolate wilderness; Surely nothing shall escape them. Their appearance is like the appearance of horses; And like swift steeds, so they run. With a noise like chariots Over mountaintops they leap, Like the noise of a flaming fire that devours the stubble, Like a strong people set in battle array. Before them the people writhe in pain; All faces are drained of color. They run like mighty men, They climb the wall like men of war; Every one marches in formation, And they do not break ranks. They do not push one another; Every one marches in his own column. Though they lunge between the weapons, They are not cut down. They run to and fro in the city, They run on the wall; They climb into the houses, They enter at the windows like a thief. The earth quakes before them, The heavens tremble; The sun and moon grow dark, And the stars diminish their brightness. The Lord gives voice before His army, For His camp is very great; For strong is the One who executes His word. For the day of the Lord is great and very terrible; Who can endure it?

Rev. 6:9-17

When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held. And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed. I looked when He opened the sixth seal, and behold, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood. And the stars of heaven fell to the earth, as a fig tree drops its late figs when it is shaken by a mighty wind. Then the sky receded as a scroll when it is rolled up, and every mountain and island was moved out of its place. And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, every slave and every free man, hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains, and said to the mountains and rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! "For the great day of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

This shows that everything in the New Testament has a reference in the Old Testament. It also shows you what our "by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and [by] our gathering together unto him" (2 Thess 2) is all about.

**Notice the two passages below ask the same question referring to exactly the same event which refer to exactly the same day!!!

Joel 2:11

The Lord gives voice before His army, For His camp is very great; For strong is the One who executes His word. For the day of the Lord is great and very terrible; *Who can endure it?*

Rev 6:17

"For the great day of His wrath has come, and *who is able to stand?*"

**At Joel 2:11 we are the Army of the Lord.

Matt 24:31

And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his *elect* from the four winds, from one {end} of {heaven} to the other.

1 Cor. 15:52

In a moment, in the {twinkling} of an {eye}, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1 Thess. 4:16

For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the {dead} in Christ shall rise {first}: 17 Then we which are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. 18 Wherefore comfort one another with these words. **

Read Joel 2:1-11 again and you will see.

I once was confronted by an old Born-Again Hebrew Rabbi and I had not heard of this old Rabbi's take on The Day of the Lord from this angle before. It adds a lot to the overall picture of the purpose of the Rapture and he taught me this Vital Endtime Key. He explained it this way to me:

You have to understand that God's Hebrew People have been looking for God to send a man to raise up an army to drive out God's People's enemies since before Jesus' time on this earth. They even expected Jesus to accomplish this when He was here but they didn't understand that real purpose for His coming. The Jews today are still praying for the Day of the Lord to come. It is the whole crux of the end times for the People of God. We are the army that does the work of burning off the filth that has infected the earth. There are powerful principles to be understood here.

The same way Abraham was willing to sacrifice Isaac, his only son, also obligated God to do the same with His only begotten son. This same action for action shows why God was so mad at David when he didn't do as God told him to do and kill everything the enemy had right down to the last man, including cattle. When David didn't do as God had said, David didn't know the principle behind why God said to kill them all. Yet at David's last public address (2 Sam. 22, Psalm 18) the Lord Prophesied through David the coming Day of the Lord that would rain destruction on God's enemy and utterly destroy them.

The Jewish people have never forgotten this. Why do you think people were so excited when Jesus spoke of these things? He was quoting from these same passages about the Day of the Lord and that is one of the reasons people thought He came to destroy the Romans and deliver the people from God's enemies. That is the very reason the people then chose Barabbas over Jesus because He had failed them. This promise of God to destroy their enemies is the most important issue to these people to this very day. They don't care who gets it done either. That is why the Anti-Christ could be anybody.

He also said to me:

If for one moment you see the Truth and then turn from it having cursed it in saying, "it's not so" ... there is hope for you to find the Truth again, but if you spit in God's eye and call Him a liar and choose to believe something that is not

true. That is another matter entirely. Ask Peter and Judas. Which do you choose, the truth or a lie? Many have chosen the lie. What bloody, murderous, loathing, seething, hatred will be in men's hearts when that lie fails to come to pass because they weren't ready for what comes after. There will be tribulation (affliction) then ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be again.

The Finale

I have an intense piece of info to pass on to you that many others don't have a clue about and it is one of the key things that was sealed up in the Little Scroll from Daniel the Prophet and from what John saw in Revelation then told not to write down and is the very thing that was kept secret until this time of ours and is the Revelation to John.

The key to this secret begins in the time of Nimrod and what he did in his time that made him the antichrist of his time. The answer to the Tower of Babel and who Nimrod was and what he did is the deepest darkest secret in the history of the world from Adam to this day.

Nimrod was the first man to become the one sovereign ruler of the entire world of his time. In the system Nimrod set in place, he fully opened the separation between the spirit realm and this world and created the events of Genesis 6 that allowed the conditions that allowed the Nephilim to overthrow the world and caused Noah's flood.

One world ruled by one man caused this. One man! Now you know the reason that every empire in history had the ultimate goal and drive to rule and control ALL the world as one empire with one master ruler and the Ultimate Reason that God never again, after Nimrod, let any one man rule the entire world. This is the KEY to the Little Scroll having to be kept secret until the chosen time... NOW!

The tower of Babel wasn't just a tower it was a temple and Nimrod used it to open the door to the spirit realm by controlling such a vast majority of people as a whole to use their collective force in their collective spirits to open that DOOR... simply because so many people were all in agreement in one accord forced open that door for the fallen ones to enter in.

Key secret: the falling away; the one world government; the antichrist being one ruler of all the world government; the great delusion that brings such a vast majority of the world population in agreement and in one accord; the moment of

the abomination of desolation brings about the opening of the abyss and the beginning of the great tribulation and the beginning of the end of satan's world system FOREVER!!!

This is why the time when Jesus becomes the One Sovereign Ruler of the earth there will be no other ruler but Him and this is the reason he couldn't have been the ruler 2000 years ago when He walked on this earth. Such a move would have made a world where satan's own (the ones with the spirit of the Nephilim) and God's Family would have to live in absolute conflict together hand in hand 'till the end of the earth.

What I have seen is far too horrible to even imagine as yet. These birth pains we are seeing in the world are spiritual earthquakes. The tribulation has already begun in the spirit and is very soon to crash intensely into the natural world and people are about to reach the breaking point. I am sorry to say that I am not ready for this.

I conclude with this from the Aramaic Peshitta Text

Ephesians 3:9-11:

And that I might enlighten all men that they may see what is the dispensation of the mystery which for ages had been hidden from the world by God who created all things; to the intent that through the church the manifold wisdom of God may be made known to the angels and powers which are in the heaven, which is the wisdom He prepared in ages past and has carried out in Jesus Christ our Lord.

We are starting into the beginning of sorrows now. How much of the end of this age are you ready for?
